All program participants are expected to volunteer for the Chamber's Winterland Parade and/or the Chamber Golf Tournament. This allows the participants to work as part of a volunteer team and to give back to others.

Even though emergencies do arise, any participant missing more than 1 session, for whatever reason, may be asked to withdraw from the program and no portion of the tuition shall be refunded.
